

SAFETY AWARENESS REFRESHER

Course Outline for Candidates



Course Title	WJA – Safety Awareness Refresher (SA Refresher or SA Recap)
Brief Description	<p>This two hour classroom session is aimed at:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • People who operate water jetting equipment and want to renew their jetting certificate / card. • A personal copy of the appropriate code of practice for water jetting “Red or Blue code” is provided during the course and this document is used as a reference throughout. • People who manage and design tasks using water jetting equipment. <p>This course provides a recap of knowledge and understanding of water jetting by discussion prior to taking the required module which will renew their jetting card / certificate and must be taken before a module to renew their card.</p> <p>Renewal of a card will be SA Refresher and a module which is already on their card.</p>
Delivery	Classroom and practical module (operational)
Why?	<p>Assists in the compliance with Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 (HASWA 74). High pressure water jetting is very hazardous; therefore, it is a requirement for anyone involved in water jetting to have knowledge and understanding of the hazards involved in water jetting so they can operate safely.</p> <p>This course is aimed at candidates wanting to renew their card / certificate for a further 3 years and has been designed to refresh the candidate on the main aspects of the original Safety awareness course.</p> <p>This course can also be used as a useful recap for new candidates who have recently passed their safety awareness and are awaiting their module.</p>
Timings	6 hours minimum (In total with a module)
Who Should Attend	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New operational candidates. • Managers • Supervisors • Site owners • Permit issuers • Health and safety Managers / officers <p>This course is for Operational candidates who are looking to renew their cards as they must take this SA refresher/ recap and a module which is already on their card.</p>
Key Features	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facilitated Group discussions • Question and Answer sessions (Verbal) • Review of accidents in the industry • Use of personal knowledge within the training group which is facilitated by the instructor.
Content –Topics covered	<p>The training workshop covers the following topics:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Introduction to the SA refresher 2. Code of practice 3. People 4. Hoses 5. Safety devices 6. Tooling 7. Accidents 8. Hazards 9. Management of jetting tasks

Content - candidate outcomes	<p>This course will equip delegates with the tools to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Candidates that are renewing their certificate / card will receive a copy of the WJA code of practice. • Candidates that have recently attended a safety awareness course will sit this course as a refresher and will retain the code provided on the original course. • Review of best practice contained within the code. • Understand the basic hazards involved with High Pressure water jetting • Understand health and safety and the hierarchy of control when applied to a water jetting task • Have knowledge of the potential damage a water jet / pressurised system failure can achieve. • Have knowledge of the different types of water jetting pump • Understand types of water jetting system and how to identify each system type • Know the pressure ratings of safety devices and equipment • Understand what can go wrong within a water jetting task • Be able to know what to do in case of a water jetting accident / injury
Pre Course Requirements	<p>To be at least 16 years of age and employed by a company or in a structured training course. To be at least 18 years of age if unemployed or not on a structured training course. To be able to understand English</p> <p>To have an in date WJA card to be renewed within +/- 3 months of the expiry date.</p>
